



Welcome to the RM!

We have faced many challenges since we started in the Longhorn business in 1978. We learned the highs and lows of floods and droughts and the peaks and valleys that the cattle market historically faces. The year 2011 tested us as never before with a record drought in all of Texas, much of Oklahoma and parts of Louisiana which impacted many Texas Longhorn breeders and a large percentage of the breed's cattle. Many cattle had to be sold or relocated due to lack of pasture, depleted water supplies or the high cost and lack of availability of hay. Coupled with the challenges of nature was a struggling economy that effected all of us. For many of us the new year brought encouragement as rains had returned starting in mid November and by the first of January many of us had moisture in the ground that they hadn't seen since September 2010. As this is being written much of Texas is wet and expecting another round of thunderstorms in the next two days. Ponds are once again holding water and creeks are flowing again. Our cattle have been chasing green for the last month and are starting to mend from the tough times.

Many of us may wonder "what lies ahead"? As a breed we have much for which to be thankful. The drought forced most of us to cull our herds much deeper than we would have liked. Short-term this was a painful process but long-term this gave us drastic improvement of our herds from top to bottom and put us several years ahead of the pace of improvement of our cattle had this not been forced on us. Many of us are lightly stocked and with the good rains will have abundant grass this spring. Our biggest challenge now becomes our market. Obviously there would be a market decline when the economy takes a downturn and when severe drought effects a large percentage of our breeders. Hopefully as we recover we can once again concentrate on spreading the word about our wonderful cattle and attracting new breeders. Our cattle are a natural choice for many people when stocking their farm or ranch and as things get back to normal people need to be told about how great this breed is and how much fun these cattle have to offer. We encourage all breeders to take an active roll in this business either through their local affiliate, one of the registries or at TLMA.

We would like to thank all who attend our sale with a special thank you to our consignors. These fine folks have sent us some exceptional cattle and we appreciate their continued support of our sale. We have held our numbers down over past sales mainly due to the effects of the drought. A close inspection of the cattle reveals an outstanding set of mainly young cattle as well as some very big horned cows and some heifers out of elite cows. Whether you are building a herd or need to add something special to the top of your herd there are cattle in this sale that will meet your needs. We continue to raise our standards in the Babydoll Heifer Sale and this year we required at least a 50" TTT measurement at 24 months of age. We also added a new class to the heifer sale, that being heifers of any age out of over 70" cows. We are pleased to have several of these in the sale and their dam's are on display. We consider this offering to be an exceptional buying opportunity for all of us.

For the first time we are offering "one breeding" to two of our best and most beautiful cows. Lots 45 and 46 deserve your attention. We also are offering two daughters of the late Buzz Saw. We only had one calf crop out of him and these are two very fancy heifers.

We hope you will find something to add to your program. We want to extend a special invitation to everyone to attend the Red McCombs Party after the heifer sale. All animals are eligible for interstate shipment except as otherwise noted. The cattle have been tested for tuberculosis and Bangs disease within 30 days of sale date. A certificate will be furnished.

6. Announcements

Announcements from the auction box take precedence over printed matter in this catalog. All cattle will be sold by lot numbers, as announced by auctioneer.

7. Breeding Guarantee

(A) All animals are guaranteed to be breeders with the exception of: (a) injury or disease occurring after sale, (b) negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the purchaser.

(B) Any female is considered a breeder if she is pregnant at the time of this sale and/or she has a calf at side.

(C) Any bull which either: (1) produces viable semen; (2) settles 1/3 or more of the healthy cows he serves; (3) is the sire of 20 or more animals; or (4) settles cows by natural service, and passes a fertility test made by a competent veterinarian during any six month period trial, shall be considered a breeder.

(D) Buyer must notify seller within one year of any breeding problem found in an animal.

8. Embryo Transfer Guarantee

All donor cows that have been worked successfully in embryo transfer are guaranteed to produce good embryos with the exception of other guarantees stated in the footnotes of this catalog or announced from the auction block. It is understood that these guarantees are valid only if: (1) a qualified person or persons do the transfer; (2) donor cow is managed properly in embryo transfer (i.e. not over conditioned and/or overworked); (3) injury or disease does not occur after the sale and (4) the purchaser is not negligent or willfully mistreats the donor cow.

9. Options and Privileges for Return or Adjustment

(A) All claims for adjustment or return must be made in writing within six months of the sale date.

(B) Any animal that has not proven itself a breeder within the time limits specified above, if in healthy condition, may be returned to seller at buyer's expense. The seller reserves the right and privilege of trying for a period of six months to prove the animal a breeder. If proven a breeder, an animal will be returned at buyer's expense. Should the animal fail to breed, the seller, at his option, may either return the purchase price or make replacement of the animal with another of equal value.

(C) Any animal returned must have a veterinarian's certificate that it is free of Bangs and tuberculosis.

10. Rights and Obligations

(A) The above terms and conditions of sale shall constitute a contract between the buyers and sellers of each animal and shall be equally binding upon both.

(B) Animals resold following the purchase in this sale shall constitute a separate transaction, and the rights and obligations of the two parties connected thereto are not covered by the terms and conditions of this sale.

(C) All persons who attend the sale do so at their own risk and the owners nor any person connected with the management of the sale assume any liability, legal or otherwise, for any accidents which may occur.

11. Applicable Law

All cattle (or horses) in this sale are offered according to the laws of the State of Texas. The right to bid, as provided under the law, is reserved for all Consignors, including owners and their agents, unless otherwise announced by the Auctioneer.
